From Local Park to Global Icon

The story of PortAventura World begins in **1995**, when a single theme park opened its gates on the Costa Daurada. Initially named Port Aventura, it quickly gained fame for its exotic themes and thrilling rides. The project was ambitious from the start, aiming to create a unique destination that would attract visitors from across Europe and beyond.

In **2002**, the complex underwent a major transformation with the arrival of Universal Studios. It was rebranded as Universal Mediterranea, marking the first time the site expanded into a full resort with two hotels and a water park. This era brought international recognition and set the stage for future growth, although Universal eventually departed in 2004.

Following the departure of Universal, the brand evolved through several names, becoming **PortAventura European Destination Resort** in 2013. This shift emphasized its position as a leading family leisure destination in Europe. The final major rebranding occurred in 2016 with the opening of Ferrari Land, establishing the current name: PortAventura World Parks & Resort.

Today, the estate spans **119 hectares** shared between Vilaseca and Salou, featuring three distinct parks and six on-site hotels. Owned by Investindustrial and KKR, the complex has seen record revenues exceeding €241 million in 2019. Its evolution reflects a continuous commitment to innovation, combining thrills, water, and speed in one cohesive experience.

Located between Vila-seca and Salou. Local bus from the center of Vila-seca or car recommended for easy access to the complex's parking areas.

OPENING HOURS

Opening hours vary by season and park. Be sure to check the exact dates on the official website before your visit.

PRICES

From 45,6 € depending on the date and pass. Prices change with extras like Ferrari Land. {promo}.

VISIT DURATION

One day is enough for PortAventura Park if well planned. Allow two days to include Ferrari Land or the water park without rushing.

PHOTOS

Photography is allowed everywhere except during shows where flash is prohibited. Avoid bulky tripods that block queues.

AUDIENCE

Perfect for families and couples. Height restrictions apply to some attractions, to be checked according to children's age.

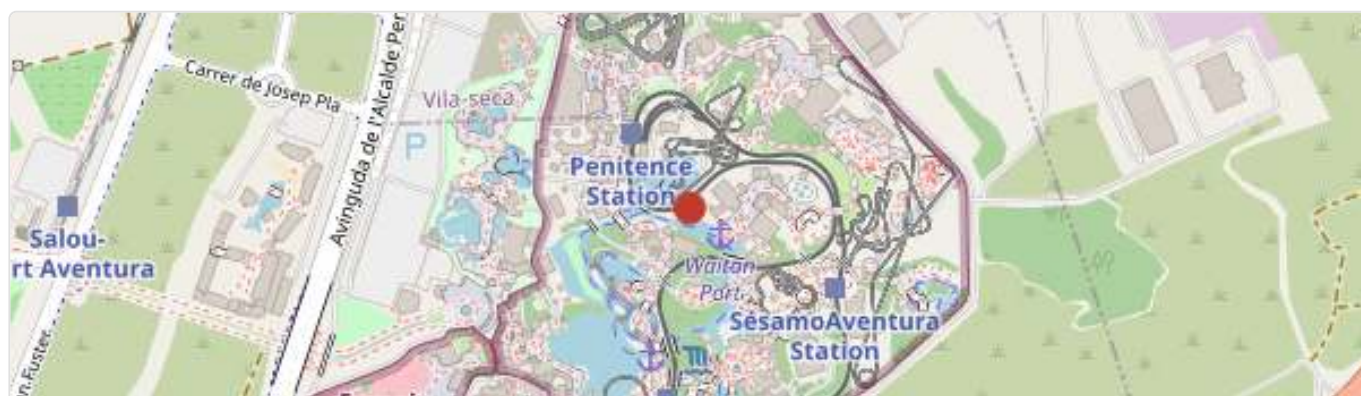

How the Three Parks Are Organized

PortAventura Park (Main Theme Park)

This is the heart of the resort, featuring six themed worlds including Far West, Polynesia, and Shambhala. With 40 attractions, it offers a mix of roller coasters, water rides, and live shows. The park is designed for families, with options for all ages.

Ferrari Land (Automotive Thrills)

Dedicated to the passion of Ferrari, this park focuses on speed and automotive experiences. It features 16 attractions, including the iconic Formula Rossa, the fastest roller coaster in the world. The decor takes you through emblematic locations in Italy.

Caribe Aquatic Park (Water Fun)

Inspired by Caribbean pirate times, this water park offers 16 attractions and pools. It is the perfect place to cool off during the summer months. The caribbean-themed decor adds to the tropical vibe.

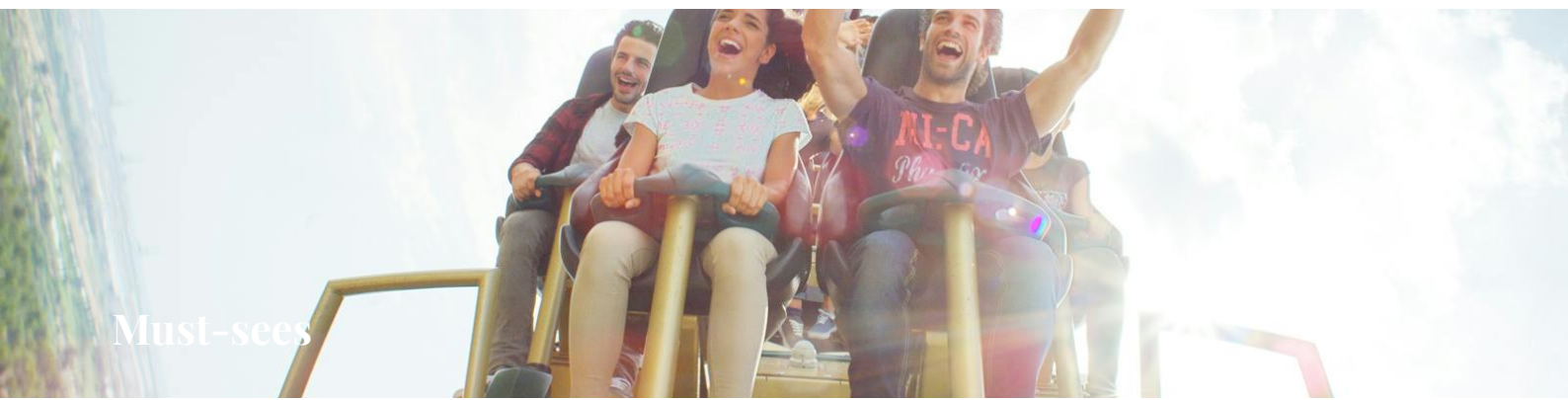

Ferrari Land

Formula Rossa

The fastest roller coaster in the world, reaching speeds of 240 km/h. It offers a breathtaking experience for thrill-seekers. The ride is a must-do for anyone visiting Ferrari Land.

💡 It holds the Guinness World Record for the fastest roller coaster, a testament to engineering excellence.

Shambhala

Shambhala Express

A wild coaster that combines steep drops and intense turns. Set in a mystical Himalayan landscape, it offers a unique visual experience. Perfect for those who love a mix of scenery and speed.

💡 The queue line itself is a journey through a detailed fantasy world, enhancing the overall immersion.

Polynesia

Temple of the Golden Skull

A dark ride that takes you on a mysterious journey through ancient temples. The combination of storytelling and effects makes it a favorite among families. It is less intense but highly engaging.

💡 The ride features intricate animatronics that bring the story to life in vivid detail.

Medierrania

Suspended Coaster

Ride upside down over the Mediterranean Sea, offering stunning views. It is a unique experience that combines height and freedom. Ideal for those who want a different kind of thrill.

💡 The view of the sea from above is often cited as the most beautiful part of the ride.

Polynesia

Tiki Tiki Summum

A giant log flume that plunges you into a tropical waterfall. The splashdown is guaranteed to leave you soaked and smiling. It is a classic attraction that never gets old.

💡 The sound of the water rushing down adds to the intensity of the drop.

Caribe Aquatic Park

Mega Splat

One of the largest water slides in the park, offering a fast and fun descent. It is perfect for groups of friends looking for some competitive fun. The slide is wide enough for multiple riders.

💡 The end of the slide is designed to maximize the splash effect, ensuring everyone gets wet.

Far West

Draco's Fire

A family-friendly coaster set in a Wild West theme. It offers gentle twists and turns suitable for younger riders. The western decor adds to the charm of the experience.

💡 The queue line features interactive elements that engage children while they wait.

Polynesia

Lago de los Monos

A calm boat ride through a lush jungle environment. It is a relaxing way to see the park's flora and fauna. Perfect for taking a break from the high-intensity rides.

💡 The boat passes under waterfalls, providing a refreshing mist in hot weather.

TIPS

Smart Tips for Your Visit

TIMING

Arrive exactly at 10:00 AM to minimize queues for flagship attractions. The first hour offers the shortest waits, allowing you to chain together key rides before crowds build.

PARCOURS

Use the official app to track real-time wait times and show schedules. This allows you to optimize your daily route and adjust plans midday without stress.

PAUSE

Eat early or late to avoid fully booked themed restaurants during peak hours. Takeaway options and snacks near attractions can save you 30 minutes in line.

AUDIOGUIDE

An audioguide is available in French, English, Spanish, and Catalan. While not essential for rides, it enhances the experience in themed areas with historical or cultural narratives.

BILLET

Compare combined packages before purchasing. Adding Ferrari Land or Caribe Aquatic Park separately often costs more than buying a multi-park pass upfront.

PHOTO

Photography is allowed everywhere except during shows where flash is prohibited. Avoid bulky tripods that block queues, and focus on capturing the themed environments.

ENFANTS

Check height restrictions for attractions before your visit. Knowing these thresholds avoids disappointment on site for young visitors and helps plan a suitable itinerary.

CONFORT

Wear comfortable sneakers as the complex spans 119 hectares with lots of walking. Avoid heels or heavy boots that tire you quickly during long days between parks.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

FAQ

What is the price of a PortAventura World ticket?

The price starts at 45,6 € but varies depending on the date and pass chosen. The price increases if you add extras like access to Ferrari Land. Always verify the exact details at the time of purchase.

Can I buy a combined PortAventura and Ferrari Land ticket?

Yes, passes exist to access multiple parks over the same period. It's advisable to compare combined rates with separate purchases, as adding them may cost more. Check availability specific to your dates before confirming

Is it possible to change my visit date after purchase?

Conditions depend on the type of ticket and the seller. Most flexible tickets allow changes, but you should read the terms and conditions before confirming. If in doubt, contact customer service right after purchase.

Do you need to book your accommodation with the ticket?

It is not mandatory, but the hotels in the complex sometimes offer benefits on park access. If you stay on site, check whether entry is included in your package. Otherwise, buy your tickets separately for more flexibility

How long does it take to visit PortAventura Park?

A full day is recommended to explore the six worlds of the main park. Two days allow you to comfortably include Ferrari Land or the water park. A half-day is only enough for a very quick discovery.

Three Parks, One Estate

The complex includes three distinct parks across 119 hectares shared between Vila-seca and Salou. This area lets you alternate thrills, water, and speed without leaving the main site. The integration of these diverse experiences is a key feature of the resort.

Brand Evolution

From Universal Mediterranea in 2002 to PortAventura World Parks & Resort in 2016, the name changed with each major opening. Each rebranding corresponds to the addition of a new unit, reflecting the growing scope of the destination.

Revenue Record

Revenue exceeded €200 million for the first time in 2016, reaching €241.5 million in 2019. This growth reflects the complex's increasing attractiveness and successful marketing strategies across Europe.

Integrated Accommodation

The resort features six on-site hotels and a seventh off-site, offering a complete experience. Staying on site makes park access easier and often provides specific benefits on tickets, enhancing the overall value.

Beyond the gates of PortAventura World, the surrounding area offers plenty of opportunities for relaxation and exploration. **Salou Beach** is perfect for unwinding after a day of thrills, with its golden sands and clear waters.
